

## **ChiTown Showdown INFORMATION**

- All Teams will play minimum 3 Games - 2 Round Robin and Playoff Game(s)
- Roster Max 12 players
- Team must wear same color T-Shirt/Jersey with Numbers on them
- Every Player must sign Waiver Form before they are allowed to play
- Tournament Location and Schedule will be finalized after Registration Deadline
- \$100 Deposit to secure your spot
- Payment must be paid in full by Friday, 7/21/2023
- Teams will get 5 minute Warm Up Time Before Games
- **Teams must provide scoreboard operator or scorebook keeper**
- Teams Provide Own First – Aid Kits (Ice Will be Provided by facility)
- Concessions will be provided

## **ChiTown Showdown GAME RULES**

- \*IHSAA rules apply unless otherwise noted.
- \*1st half 20 minutes and 2nd half 20 minutes, Clock Stops last minute of first half and two minutes of 2nd half (Halftime is 3 Minutes upon teams returning to bench)
- \*Games will be officiated by certified IHSAA referees
- \*Once a team reaches a 20 point lead, the clock will not stop until the lead gets cut below 15 pts (unless a timeout is taken).
- \*Coaches will have 3 timeouts per game to use at their discretion. In overtime, each team will be given 1 timeout for overtime (No Carryover) - No timeouts in sudden death
- \*Technical Fouls and Flagrant Fouls result in two free throws and possession (2nd technical is ejection from the game coach or player)
- \*Overtime will be Two minute long with clock stopping on all whistles. Second overtime - sudden death. Team must score two points to win but does not have to win by 2 points.

## **ChiTown Showdown CODE OF CONDUCT**

- Damage – Any person responsible for any damage to the facilities, other people's property, etc, will be ejected from the tournament and held liable for any costs.
- Fighting – Any parent, spectator or coach involved in any type of physical altercation will be automatically ejected from the venue and the tournament. Parents and spectators can also be removed for excessive verbal abuse of officials, other spectators or MYBA Hoops / CKBA Staff.
- Protests or Complaints – Should be directed to an on-site facility supervisor. Any decisions regarding complaints or protests are solely the responsibility of the Tourney Director
- Parent/Spectator Rule: All Teams are responsible for the conduct of their parents and spectators in the gym. If any behavioral problems occur, head coaches will be asked to control their parent/spectators behavior. In

the event the parent/spectator will not behave appropriately at the request of tourney director or coach, the team can be penalized with a technical foul or even forfeiture of the game at the discretion of the league/tourney director.

- Player Fights or Verbal Assaults: If a player is deemed to throw a punch he is automatically removed and suspended for all future MYBA Hoops / CKBA Events. Also, use of inappropriate/racist/sexist verbal language directed at a player is prohibited and can be penalized with ejection from a game.

**Spectators:** There are no restrictions but please provide them with the following information. **We will not open the gym to spectators until 30 minutes before the first game, so please inform families that play first games at 8AM. There will be a spectator fee of \$8 for adults 18 & Older and \$5 for 6-17 years old & Seniors.** While we want to provide parents/spectators with the experience of playing, please follow any safety guidelines of all facilities & MYBA/CKBA **and treat all staff, coaches, players, referees respectfully.** We expect parents/spectators to do everything possible to help in creating the safest environment possible for everyone involved.
